## MAINS

### Vegetarian—Volcanic Eruptions

Your task is to produce a fact file on volcanoes. You should answer the following questions:

- What is a volcano?
- How do they erupt?
- Why do people choose to live on volcanoes?
- Include a labelled diagram of a volcano

You can then have a go at making a model volcano. You may use household items such as newspaper, plastic bottles, tissue paper and toilet roll.

### Meat—American Civil Rights

The struggles between blacks and whites reached a climax in the USA in 1950s and 1960s. One major incident during this time period was at Little Rock High School in Arkansas in 1957.

Research this real life incident at Little Rock High School.

Then, using your research, write a diary entry as if you were a child at the school, outlining:

- What happened
- Why it happened
- What the consequences of it were
