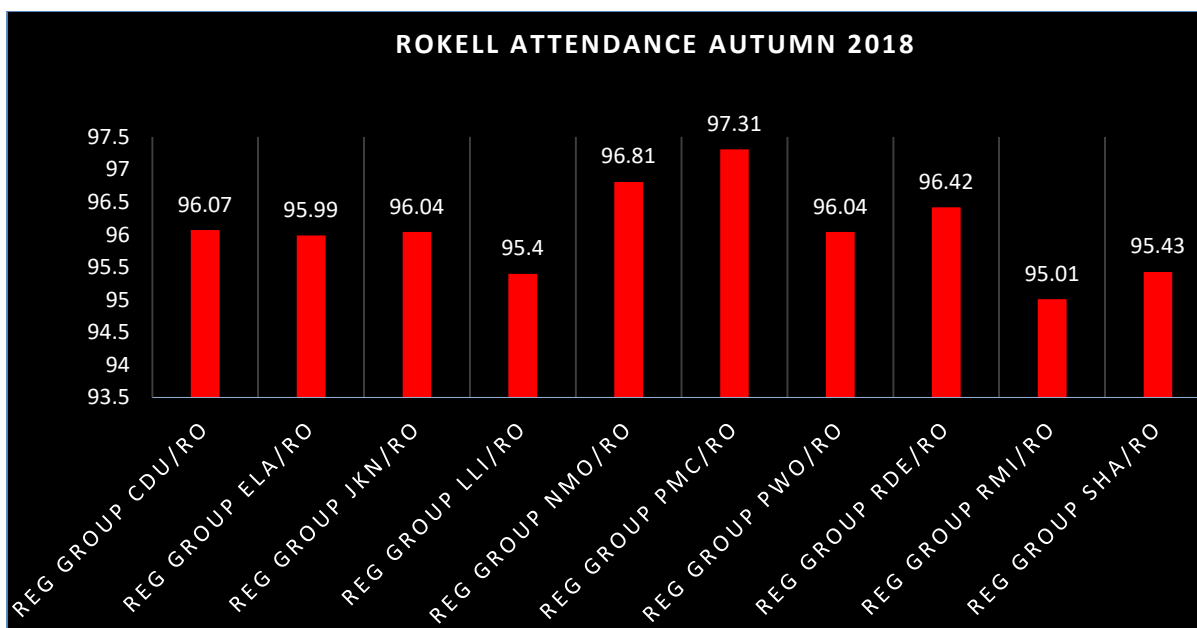
Inter-House Challenges
