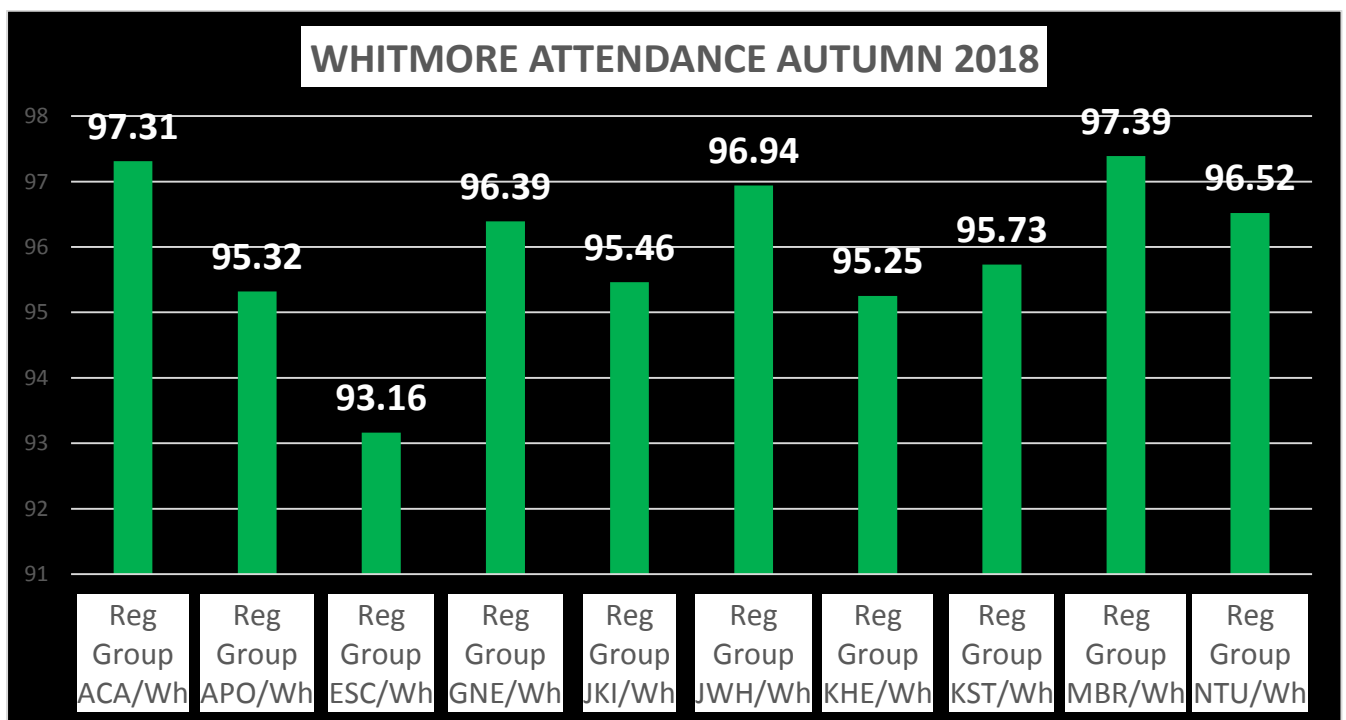
### Inter-House Challenges
